Dear Parents/Guardians,

Halloween festivities will take place on **Tuesday, October 31st, 2017**. To ensure that our school community has a safe and successful day, please review the information below.

- Please send your child to school dressed in their costumes and with all make-up applied on Tuesday, October 31st.
- Place all costume accessories in a bag labeled with your child's name.
- For safety reasons please ensure that your child's costume is not too long as to accommodate the steps on the bus or for your child to safely walk along the parade route.
- Costumes should be safe and appropriate for school and represent a non-violent character.
 - Toy weapons or props will **not** be permitted to accompany a costume (i.e., swords, knives, guns, bows, skateboards, balls etc.)
 - Please refrain from clown costumes
- If the temperature is cold, please remember to send in jackets.
- **The parade will begin at 1:45 P.M. outside (see below), weather permitting**
 - Children will be parading in the back of the school.
 - Parents should stand on the outside of the designated cones along our parade route.
 - **Parking is at a premium. Please carpool if you are able.**
 - The parade will take place in the gymnasium if there is inclement weather. Additional information will follow, if necessary.

To ensure the safety of our staff and students, only pre-approved volunteers that will be assisting classroom teachers with afternoon events will be allowed to enter the school building after the parade. If you are a parent assisting with party details, please remember to sign-in at the main office. We will have a visitor's tag waiting for you.
