

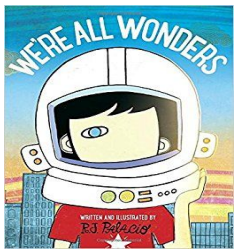
Violence and Vandalism Prevention Week

Wednesday, October 18th: Peace Out Day
